

AFT: JOIN A CENSUS COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE

A Complete Count Committee is composed of a broad spectrum of government and community leaders from education, business, healthcare and other community organizations. These trusted messengers develop and implement a 2020 census-awareness campaign using their knowledge of the local community to encourage completion of the census form.

Tribal, state and local governments work together with partners to form CCCs to promote and encourage active participation in the 2020 census in their communities. Community-based organizations also establish CCCs that reach out to their constituents. **AFT leaders and members can participate in CCCs to ensure that the people in our communities are counted so they can get appropriate representation and resources for the next decade.**

Children ages birth to 5 and immigrants are most at risk of being undercounted in the 2020 census. AFT teachers and other school personnel are among those most trusted by parents, and they understand how, where and when to discuss the census in communities.
