Job Duties:

The collective bargaining intern will update and maintain the collective bargaining database. Under the supervision of the AFT Research, Strategic Initiatives and Economic Security Department, the intern will scan collective bargaining agreements for usable data, transfer contract information into database structure, and participate in team meetings/discussions on data structure and improvements to the database. The intern will be responsible for tracking state legislative issues that may affect contract entry; accessing online databases to find information; communicating and working with AFT staff across many departments to find solutions to datarelated issues; and responding to periodic data requests.

Internship Terms:

- The intern may be an undergraduate, graduate student or a postdoctoral researcher. The program is
 open to individuals from all academic backgrounds. Preferred applicants will have prior
 experience working with collective bargaining agreements.
- The intern is expected to commit 12 months to the fellowship and final project.
- Familiarity with Excel and other database programs and attention to detail are a must.
