Job Duties:

Interns will assist with research related to the following areas, depending on need: corporate and industry analysis, economic development research, state legislative analysis and fiscal analysis. Most assignments will require online research, accessing online databases, and analysis of data or reports obtained through public records requests. Interns will gain experience assisting with publications, responding to daily data requests, and with the wide-ranging activities of our staff who work with all AFT constituencies. Appropriate training will be provided.

This position is available immediately; preference will be given to those able to work full time.

Qualifications:

Candidates should have a commitment to social justice and/or labor organizing; good writing and communication skills and an ability to learn quickly, work well with a team, and handle multiple projects and tight deadlines. Work or volunteer experience with progressive/activist organizations is helpful. Familiarity with Lexis and other online databases, Excel and related applications is useful, but not required.
