Receive free trauma counseling if you've been a victim of bullying, harassment or threats on the job due to hate and bigotry.













Members are experiencing a rise in incidents of antisemitism and Islamophobia. Threats of violence and intimidation due to hate and bigotry for someone's race, religion, sexual orientation, politics or other characteristics/personal choices create an environment that puts workers at risk. Threats can come in many ways—verbal, physical intimidation, written threats, social media attacks and more.
